TMSCA Improves On-Line Meet Format for 2014-2015

TMSCA will again host a series of on-line meets for our TMSCA members this year. TMSCA listened to suggestions from our coaches and made changes to improve the format of our on-line meets. We have expanded the testing window of the meets to allow more flexibility for testing opportunities for the coaches. Also, we would suggest if you are one of many schools who test 20 or students that you have a contest within your school to determine whose scores will actually be posted to the website. For instance if you test 50 students in NS,

then tell your students that only the top 20 will be posted to the website. This may provide an additional incentive for students to perform better. All of your students still get the opportunity to test under contest conditions, but it lessens your workload when posting scores to the website. In order for this type of contest to achieve its full potential, we really need all of our coaches to post their scores.

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

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TMSCA Executive Board meets in June

Members set tentative dates for high school, championship meets

The following items were discussed and actions taken (if needed) at the TMSCA Executive Board meeting June 21, 2014.

2014 HS State Meet: The board discussed the proofing of the high school state meet tests prior to the meet (instituted for the 2014 meet) and agreed that it is best, if possible, to use retired or non-active coaches for proofing the state tests ahead of time. The board all agreed that proofing the tests ahead of time is for the best. We had 88 schools compete and 2302 tests were given.

2014 Middle School Championship Meet: There were over 2700 students at the meet from 198 schools. Over 5000 tests were given. This was one of the largest meets we have ever had.

UIL Liaison Report: The board gave an official TMSCA position on calculator usage on the high school science test. After discussion, the board agreed that TMSCA's position will be to endorse the same calculator usage policy that has been in effect by UIL in the past.

Executive Secretary's Report: The TMSCA calendar for next year was discussed. The high school state meet will be a week later, March 21, 2015, due to the date of the first week of district UIL. The middle school championship meet will be on April 11, 2015. Both of these dates are pending approval from UT San Antonio.

A report on the online meets from the past year was given. We had 30 schools in the Kickoff meet in October, 19 schools in the Gear Up meet in January, and 31 schools in the Tune Up meet in March. The Board voted to continue the Elementary practice materials/online meet for another year.

It was reported we had an increase in meals purchased at the state meets this year since we offered the vegetarian meals. We will include the vegetarian meal pre-order request on the registration form for the state meets this year.

Treasurer's Report: The Board discussed purchasing some portable sound systems to be used for the awards ceremonies at state. This will be decided after information on cost is presented to the Board in December. The Board will investigate investing contingency funds in a CD, with a decision pending more detailed information on rates and terms.

Capital Conference: TMSCA will be represented at the Capital Conference. We have some shirts and other things to give as door prizes. Packets for distribution will also include a CD with sample high school, middle school and elementary tests on it.

UIL classification and TMSCA Constitution: The constitution states in many places "classifications 1A-5A." A motion was made to amend the constitution in all appropriate places to say "UIL classifications," to align with the new UIL classifications, 1A-6A. After discussion, the Board approved to present these constitutional amendments to the membership to be voted on at the 2015 business meetings.

Combination of 1A & 2A Classifications: Article 5, Section 4, Part C will be amended to say "classifications may be combined as deemed necessary for awards purposes." This will be voted on at the 2015 business meetings. It was decided to implement these changes for the 2014-2015 school year, prior to the constitution change in the spring of 2015

Computer Program Update and Requests: The board discussed the option of adding order forms for T-shirts, practice rooms and meals into the computer program so they can be completed when schools register for the state meet.

Calendar: The Board approved the calendar presented with the last test date for HS testing being 2/28/15.

On-Line Meets: The board voted to continue the online meets for 2014-2015 as in previous years.

Chatsworth Machine and Grading: The program is now ready to add the Chatsworth cards to the meet process. It will be tested at select meets across the state prior to the state meets.

Newspaper: Since the newspaper is being replaced by usage of the website, the following recommendations were made: The newspaper will be reduced to four issues for the upcoming year (September, December, April and May). This change is effective for the 2014-2015 year and will be re-visited for 2015-2016. After future review, the newspaper may be completely phased out if it is determined that the website is now being utilized by the majority of the TMSCA membership to replace all information previously offered in the newspaper.

2014-2015 Budget: After reviewing all the line items in the proposed budget, the Board adopted the budget as proposed.

December Executive Board Meeting Date: The board will meet on Saturday, December 13, 2014.

order to register for the meets (Exception: Middle Schools may participate in the Kick-Off Meet based on prior year membership). You must register your school using the TMSCA on-line registration program (same one used for state meets last year). [A link to the TMSCA Registration website is on the TMSCA website under the TMSCA Meets tab \(Registration Link\)](#). For a flat \$50 fee, you can test as many students from your school as you would like in as many contests as you choose to enter them in. Tests are distributed electronically to each school registered. The coach then downloads and prints the tests. That school then has a 10-14 day minimum window in which to administer the tests to their students, grade their own tests and post their results to the TMSCA registration website. Posting of scores may begin 5 days prior to the close of the testing window (giving coaches about one week to get their scores posted). Once the deadline for testing has closed,

TMSCA will compile all the results and post them on the TMSCA website: www.tmsca.org. You must post your scores to the website. The success of this type of meet is dependent on the integrity of our coaches, their diligence in maintaining test security, and their promptness in posting their testing results to the website. The testing at each school must be done in a single sitting for each test (i.e. Number Sense, Calculator, etc.). However, each test can be administered on a different day. Testing times can be flexible according to the coach's schedule, but test security must be maintained on that campus.

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A synopsis of TMSCA's 4 contests

Number Sense

Number Sense involves a 10-minute, 80-question mental math test covering all high school mathematics courses. Shortcuts need to be developed and practiced in order to compete and finish the test.

Science

This contest challenges students to do a wide range of reading in biology, chemistry and physics, to gain an understanding of the significance of experiments rather than to recall details, to be alert to new discoveries and information in the areas of science, to gain an understanding of the basic principles as well as knowledge of the history and philosophy of science, and to foster a sense of enthusiasm about how science affects our lives.

Calculator Applications

This contest includes calculations involving addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, roots, powers, exponential, logarithms, trigonometric functions and inverse trigonometric functions. In addition to straightforward calculation problems, the contest includes geometric and stated problems similar to those found in algebra, geometry and trigonometry textbooks, previous contests and League materials related to the contest.

Mathematics

This contest is designed to test knowledge and understanding in the areas of algebra I and algebra II, geometry, trigonometry, math analysis, analytic geometry, pre-calculus and elementary calculus.
