# TMSCA adds elementary testing materials to its resources

Based on feedback from member schools across the state, TMSCA will begin offering a Test Pool of materials aimed at grades 3-5 in each of our four contest areas: Number Sense, Calculator, Math and Science. These materials will be offered in an introductory package at a cost of \$100.

The package will include five practice tests in each contest. These materials will be drawn from the 3rd–5th grade TEKS, with advanced select challenge problems coming from 6-8th grade TEKS. Each test set will be formatted according to TMSCA/UIL specifications.

These materials are aimed at the novice/beginner student and are intended to assist in the early development of competitive math and science

skills. They will provide an excellent place to start your younger students and teach them both test-taking skills and the fundamentals of each contest before they move on to the middle school tests. They can even be used as a starting point to teach your older beginner students in 6-8th grades contest fundamentals and to help them work on speed drills, especially in Number Sense and Calculator.

In addition to the total of 20 tests offered (five in each of four contests), the package includes entry into our online elementary meet for your school. To accommodate schools across the state who host their districts meets at different times during the year (either spring or fall), this meet will be offered *Continued on page 5*

# 2013-14 test pool to be distributed electronically

Distribution of the 2013-2014 TM-SCA Test Pool for both high school and middle school will be done electronically.

In order to make these tests more readily available as teaching tools for our coaches in a more timely manner, the tests will be posted weekly in a shared folder on Google Drive. Each week coaches will be able download the tests from the previous Saturday's TMSCA competition, print them and have immediate access to them.

Coaches will be issued an invitation to share the items in the folder when their order for the 2013-2014 Test Pool is received. They will need to bookmark this invitation in order to access the tests weekly. Coaches will also need to ensure that their school email system will allow them to download files from

a Google Drive folder. If they are unable to do so, they will need to furnish an alternate email address for access to the materials.

It will be the responsibility of each coach to determine which email address will work best for them when downloading their tests and furnish that information to the TMSCA state office on their order form. Access to the folder will always contain all tests that have been released to date. It is the hope of TMSCA that this new service will help our coaches better prepare their students for competitions.

In addition, the 2012-2013 TMSCA Test Pool will now be distributed on CD. Any test pool orders prior to 2012-2013 will still be distributed hard copy. Virtual meet tests are not included in the regular TMSCA Test Pool.

# **TMSCA Financial Procedural Changes for 2013-2014**

1. Please make sure that your district business office has the new TMSCA contact information updated in their files. Mailing to the former TM-SCA address could delay processing orders/payments for as long as two to three weeks. The new information is:

2. ALL billing will be done electronically. Billing for membership and practice/tournament test materials will be invoiced and sent to the primary

contact person listed on the membership form via email.

It will be the responsibility of the primary contact person to direct invoices for these services to the appropriate source for payment. Again, we need your help to make sure that all invoices are paid in a timely manner. Orders can be submitted in three ways: US mail, fax or scan/attach to an email.

3. When registering for TMSCA sanctioned meets, you will be able to generate and print an invoice from the website that includes all charges (entry fees, administrative fees, meals) and your student roster. This is the invoice you should submit to your business office to process for payment.

At the state meets, when you pick

up your packet, you will receive another invoice copy that will reflect any payments made at that time and/or changes made after entries closed.

Please make sure that your business office processes payment from one of these two invoices. It should not be necessary for TMSCA to bill you a third time.

For online meets, you will have the ability to print a receipt when you register online for the meet. Entry fee for all online meets (exception – elementary package online meet) is a flat \$50, and the receipt generated from the website will be for that amount. <u>Please submit that receipt to your business of fice for payment.</u>

Your help in utilizing these new procedures will be appreciated and will help TMSCA run more efficiently.

# TMSCA expands online meet program for 2013-2014

Last year, TMSCA launched a pilot program for online meets for our middle schools.

It proved highly successful with 49 schools participating in the meet. Due to this success, the Board decided to expand this program at the middle school level to three meets, add an online meet for high school and include an online meet in our introductory package of our elementary materials.

In case you are not familiar with the online meet concept, it is an economical way for you to give your students an additional opportunity to test using secure TMSCA materials at your own school, on your own schedule and then compare their results with scores from students across the state. You save the costs of individual entry fees, transportation and meals.

Here is how it works. You must have a current TMSCA membership in order to register for the meets (Exception: Middle schools may participate in the Kick-Off Meet based on prior year membership). You must register your school using the TMSCA online registration program (same one used for state meets last year). For a flat \$50 fee, you can test as many students from your school as you would like in as many contests as you choose to enter them in.

Tests are distributed electronically to each school registered. The coach then downloads and prints the tests. That school then has a one week window in which to administer the tests to their students, grade their own tests and post their results to the TMSCA registration website. Once the deadline for posting has closed, TMSCA will compile all the results and post them on the TMSCA website: tmsca.org.

The success of this type of meet is dependent on the integrity of our coaches, their diligence in maintaining test security, and their promptness in posting their testing results to the website. The testing at each school must be done in a single sitting for each test (i.e. Number Sense, Calculator, etc.). However, each test can be administered on a different day. Testing times can be flexible according to the coach's schedule, but test security must be maintained on that campus.

The September 2013 issue will be the last one to be distributed via email directly to each coach. After that, it will be the responsibility of each individual coach to check the website for each new edition, then download and print it.

Hopefully this will alleviate the problems we have seen in the past with school spam filters preventing the delivery of the paper to some of our coaches. This new delivery system will also get our TMSCA news out to a broader audience.
